ELM CREEK SINGLETRACK TRAIL



The "Easy Trail" loop of the Elm Creek Singletrack is designed to be suitable for adaptive 3 or 4-wheeled mountain bikes. The trail averages 4 feet in width, narrowing to 36" in spots. The trail surface is packed soil that is relatively smooth, but expect rough sections with obstacles up to 2" in height. The trail surface can be soft or loose due to mud or sand. Bikes with wheel diameters of 20" or greater are recommended for safety. Average trail grades are gentle (<5%) although some short sections may be steeper.

Loop A: 0.8 miles in length. The section is a gently rolling trail that circles wetlands and follows a glacial ridge through a mature forest of Maple, Oak, and Basswood.

Loop B: 1.4 miles in length. This section offers a greater vertical challenge than loop A, featuring a climb that rises 30 feet in a 900 foot distance followed by a decent of 40 feet in just over 1000 feet. Trail users will encounter a combination of open terrain with vista of wetlands and forest and dense brushy sections through old fields and young woodlands.
